



About the scholarship application process

Since its founding, the St George Community Sailing Foundation has been committed to ensuring the participation of local children. The fee for children resident year round in St George, South Thomaston, Thomaston, Cushing and Spruce Head is one half of that for children from outside the town. In addition, a limited number of scholarships are available to children resident year-round in St George, reducing their costs even further.

Our scholarship awards process is intended to ensure that those children who most need scholarships continue to receive them and are able to participate in the sailing program. We realize that financial information is sensitive, and assure you that it will be reviewed by a small subcommittee of the Board, and will be held in strictest confidence.

The Jackson Memorial Library also offers a few scholarships for the sailing program. They have moved their due date to April 1. One can apply for a Library scholarship first, and then if not awarded, still have time to apply to the St George Sailing scholarship.

To apply for a scholarship:

- Download the scholarship application form <http://www.stgeorgesail.org/regist.html> , complete and submit the scholarship application by scanning and emailing or by mail.
- Scholarship applications are due by mail or email on May 1. Notifications will be made in mid-May.
- The two-week fee for each participant receiving a scholarship is \$50, payable with the hard copy registration form by June 1.
