To date hundreds of children have sailed with us — some just one session, some year after year, and some until they became paid instructors teaching the next generation.

We are frugal, but we also need to stay safe and keep our equipment well-maintained. Our volunteer board works very hard to see that we are shipshape!

About ninety children sail with us every summer, pitting their wits against the wind, the tide, and the weather. Thank you for all you have done to make this possible, and for making sailing a part of life on the St. George peninsula. **All donations are helpful - and tax-deductible**. We also accept donations of boats for resale, which has proved to be a good source of funds for us.
